1. To report to ANU, contact the Registrar, Student Administration at registrar.student.administration@anu.edu.au.

1. To report to general duties police, call the ACT Police on 131 444. They can then refer you to the Sexual Assault and Child Abuse Team (SACAT), a trained police team, if you choose.
